
Infrastructure Rebuild Team

The Stronger Christchurch Infrastructure Rebuild Team (SCIRT) is repairing the city's earthquake damaged roads, water, wastewater and stormwater pipes.

Works Notice

9 February 2012

We are replacing the wastewater pressure main along the Esplanade from Clifton Bay to Scarborough Park. Stage 1 will start in the week of Monday 13 February 2012, and will take approximately four weeks.



The red line shows the section of the wastewater main that will be relayed in Stage 1. Please be aware of the changed traffic conditions. Reduce speed (30km/h limit).

- We are relaying the pressure wastewater main from an existing pipeline near Clifton Bay along the Esplanade to Scarborough playground, the project as a whole is expected to take approximately four months.
- Stage 1 is to relay the wastewater pressure main under Esplanade between number 140 Esplanade and Hardwicke Street and is starting in the week of Monday 13 February 2012.
- The works will take place between 7.30am and 5.30pm, Monday to Friday. Stage 1 of the works is expected to be finished by mid March. All works are subject to favourable weather and on-site construction conditions.
- The work may result in increased dust, noise and vibration levels because of underground drilling.
- Works will have little to no impact on current wastewater services.
- Works will impact on traffic movements. The two traffic lanes will be maintained but the footpath on the sea side of Esplanade will be closed. Pedestrians will be diverted along the beach front promenade. The footpath along the property boundaries will be unaffected. On-street parking is not available on the sea side of Esplanade in the immediate work zone.
- Access to properties for local residents will be maintained. Please contact us if you have any specific access requirements that we need to consider e.g. nurse/doctor visits, Meals on Wheels or planned works on your property.
- Stay safe and alert: keep children and pets at a safe distance from the work site. If you wish to speak to someone on site please go to the person furthest away from the moving machinery.
